PROGRAMS & INITIATIVES

- Food Pantry & Jewish Family Services (JFS): Provides culturally responsive food, mental health, and financial support to families in need.
- Holistic, Urgent, and Braving Support (HUBS): Rapid-response behavioral health care for individuals and families in crisis.
- Fathers Acquiring Mentorship & Enrichment (FAME): Equips fathers with skills and resources to strengthen family relationships
- Non-Custodial Parent Employment Program (NCPEP): Helps parents find work and build financial stability while maintaining family connections.
- Healthy Youth Transitions (HYT) – South Florida: Supports teens and young adults transitioning from foster care to independent living.
- Alternative Family Program (AFP): Provides behavioral health support and family stabilization for at-risk families
- Heart Gallery of Pinellas and Pasco (HGPP): Connects foster children with forever families through powerful photography and storytelling.
- Clinical Services: Provides trauma-informed therapy and behavioral health support for individuals in crisis.
- Residential Treatment Facility (RTF): Offers structured, therapeutic living environments for youth and adults in recovery
